



## Say Yes! Life Groups - Week 1 - Say Yes! To JUBILEE & JESUS

**Opening Question:** How did God impact you or speak to you during the message this past weekend?

**Video:** Play the SAY YES VIDEO that was shown during the weekend services. Share the impact this had on you and the members of your group. Don't force everyone to share but encourage them to. Use the FAQ's to help answer questions.

### **Celebrate Journey's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary/Jubilee**

Read Leviticus 25:8-10. Jubilee was essentially an economic reset of the nation of Israel's economy. In the Jubilee year **all debts were cancelled, prisoners were released, and property rights were restored to the original owner.** Which of these would have been most impactful? What will be the most impactful today?

1. Read Leviticus 25:23.  
What is God saying in this passage?  
There is no historical evidence that Jubilee was ever celebrated in Israel.  
WHY do you think it was never celebrated?  
What is something in your life you wish you had celebrated more?
2. What three things did Pastor John outline for Journey in our year of Jubilee?
3. How are we like the former slaves (Israelites) regarding our possessions?
4. Read Isaiah 61:1-2a. What is the Prophet Isaiah saying?
5. Read Luke 4:18-19. What is Jesus saying/doing in this passage? Read Luke 4:21. What is the significance of this scripture?
6. What is Journey **Saying Yes** to?  
FREEDOM? What does that entail?  
FAMILY? What does that mean/look like?  
THE FUTURE? What are our specific goals for the future?
7. What is a ONE FUND?
8. Read and recite together 2 Corinthians 1:20!
9. Close in prayer for the Say Yes! Initiative and how God is calling each household to participate.
